

## **VAIDYARATNAM AYURVEDA COLLEGE, OLLUR**

Vaidyaratnam Ayurveda College was founded by the late Ashtavaidyan E.T. Neelakandan Mooss on 2nd October 1976 and is under the management of Vaidyaratnam Ayurvedic Educational Society, registered under the Literary, Scientific and Charitable Societies Registration Act XII/1955. The College is affiliated to the Kerala University of Health Sciences and offers B.A.M.S. degree (Ayurveda acharya). The course is recognized by the Central Council of Indian Medicines (CCIM) and is of duration of 5½ years. P. G Course in Kayachikitsa was started with an intake capacity of 4 seat p.a from 2013 onwards. The College has a full fledged hospital with a bed strength of 120 which is sufficient for providing instructional and clinical facilities to the students. All the 14 teaching departments of the college are well equipped in respect of supporting facilities. The teachers are qualified as per norms of CCIM MSR. The College has got a good Library with additional department wise mini libraries. Computer and Internet facilities are available in College Library for study purpose of students. It has got a good Herbarium, X-ray unit and Ultrasonic scanner. Boys and Girls Hostels are available in the College Campus.

### **PROSPECTUS FOR BAMS COURSE**

#### **DURATION OF COURSE**

The duration of course is 5 ½ years including compulsory internship for one year.

#### **Admission Capacity:**

Total 60 seats (70% State Quota, 15% seats will be filled in through All India Quota and 9 seats (15%) under Management Quota)

The Entrance Commissioner will select candidates under State Quota of 70% seats. 15% seats under Management quota will be filled-in by the Management as per the directives of Admission Supervisory Committee.

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION UNDER MANAGEMENT QUOTA-**

1. 5 Seats reserved for Son/Daughter of Ayurveda Physicians in the State with A Class Registration of the Travancore Cochin Medical Council
2. 4 Seats reserved for Dependent of Military Personnel, either in active service or retired or killed in action subject to the condition that such dependent should be permanent residents of Kerala.

### **OTHER REQUIREMENTS-**

3. Applicants should be eligible for BAMS admission for a particular academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at **50 th percentile in NEET** for the said academic year. However in respect of candidates belonging to scheduled castes, scheduled tribes, other backward castes, the minimum marks shall be at 40 th percentile. In respect of the candidates with bench marked disabilities specified under the rights of persons with disabilities act.2016 the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for general category candidates and 40th percentile for SC/ST/OBC candidates. The percentile shall be determined on the basis of highest marks secured in the all india common merit list in NEET.
4. Candidates who have passed in the subjects physics, chemistry and biology in the higher secondary examination of the board of higher secondary education, Kerala, with 50% marks in biology separately, and 50% marks in physics, chemistry and biology put together, are eligible.

Applications of students, who fails to submit documentary evidences in support of their claim to meet eligibility conditions of Management Quota, at the time of online applications, will be summarily rejected.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

Selection under Management Quota seats will be on the basis of Merit list as assessed in the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET-UG ) Conducted by The CBSE. The admission shall be purely on inter se merit from the NEET qualified candidates only.

The college will publish the rank list students selected under Management Quota in the official web site.

## **AGE**

Applicants should have completed 17 years of age as on 31/12/2019. No age relaxation in the minimum age will be allowed.

## **APPROVALS**

The course is approved by the Government of Kerala, the CCIM and AYUSH, the central Government Department for Indian systems of medicines. From 2010, the course is recognized by the Kerala University for Health Sciences.
